Stepwise Planning Process

1. *Develop inventory and forecast of emissions*
2. Identify a full range of possible actions
3. *Identify initial priorities for analysis*
4. Develop straw proposals
5. Quantify GHG reductions and costs/savings
6. Evaluate externalities, feasibility issues
7. Develop alternatives to address barriers
8. Aggregate results
9. Iterate to final agreements
10. Finalize and report recommendations

No changes to RCI Catalog

Discussion highlights:

- Should support training of professionals
- Need increased awareness of the benefit of ground water heat pumps
- Should be mindful of the high level of energy use associated with water treatment and transport

- Complete the Catalog of Potential State Actions for Arkansas
- Develop recommendations on priority options for analysis for GCGW review/approval
- Develop recommendations for improving draft Arkansas GHG Inventory and Forecast

Balloting Process Summary

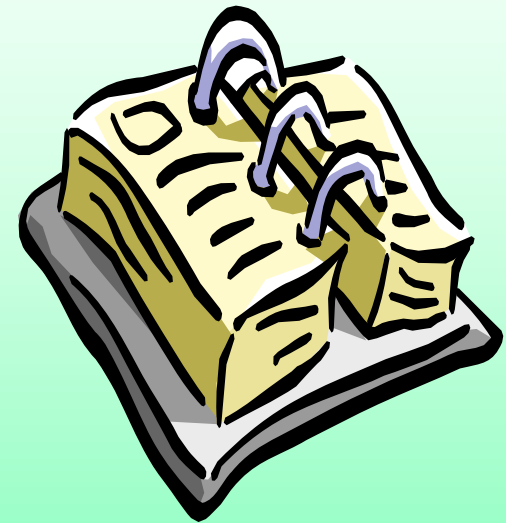
- Each TWG member to receive balloting instructions via email
